

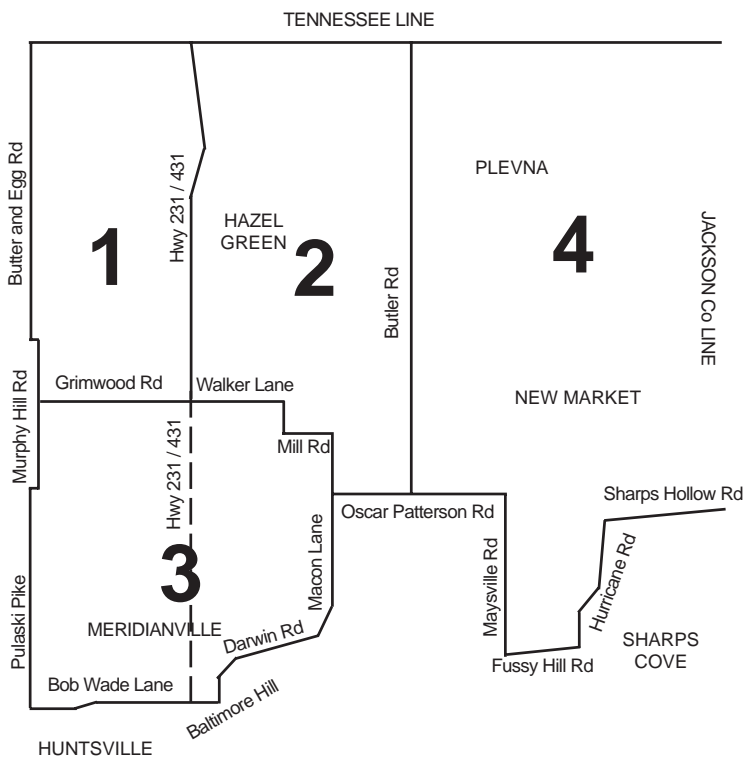
# Trash Collection for Madison County District 1

Your household garbage or recycling collection days remain the same.

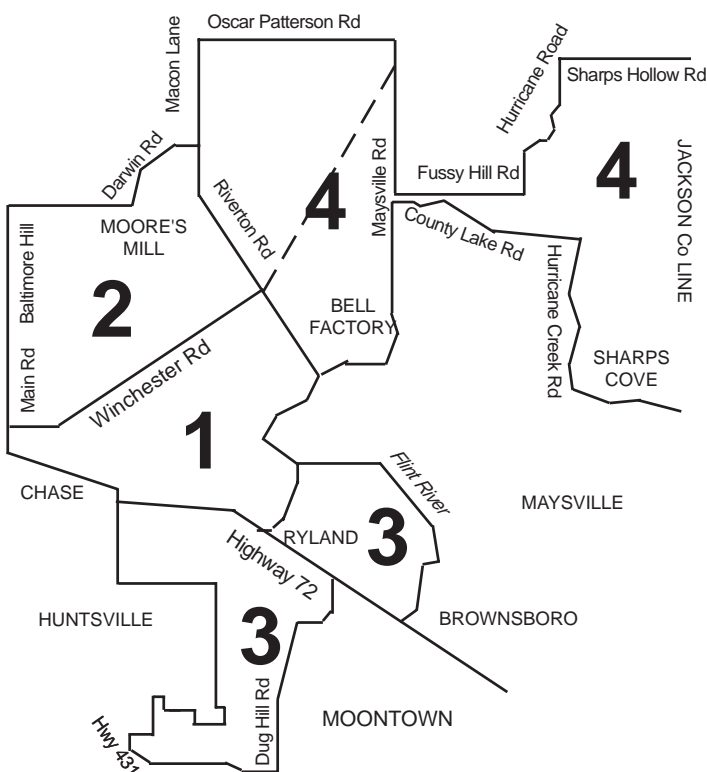

→ **FREE, if only a pickup truck load per month.**

If your trash is over the required limit, please call District 1 for **SPECIAL SERVICE**. The minimum charge is \$40. The fee depends on manpower, equipment and disposal fees.

→ **Place these items at side of the road:**

**Limbs and Brush —**

Place all brush in a separate pile. All brush must be cut 8 foot lengths or less.

**Grass Clippings and Leaves —**

Grass clippings and pine straw must be bagged. Do not place in trash cans, they will not be emptied.

**Metal Items —**

Separate into one pile. This includes: appliances, hot water heaters, chairs, iron post, all fencing and aluminum goods.

**Bulk Household Items —**

Large items such as mattresses, sofas, etc.

→ **Crews will NOT pick up:**

**Tires, automotive products, car batteries, pesticides, household batteries, paint and related products.** Please call 882-0155, the Handle With Care Collection Center, to dispose of these items.

**Construction materials such as: shingles, insulation, concrete block, bricks, rocks, cement and like materials.** Contractors must remove construction debris.

**What can I take to the District 1 Landfill ?**

→ Open Monday - Saturday 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Beth Road

**Tires**   

Automobile Tire \$1    Truck Tire \$2    Tractor Tire \$4

**Paint cans** must be placed in a special receptacle in the landfill.

**Roofing materials generated by a homeowner's improvement project,** not a contractor. There is a charge for shingle disposal of \$15 per cubic yard. A pickup truck is 4 cubic yards. Cost = \$60.
