Household garbage and recycling collection days remain the same.

**Please place items at side of road:**

## **Limbs, Brush, Grass Clippings & Leaves**

Put in a separate pile.

Must be cut in 8 foot lengths or less

Grass clippings, leaves, & pine straw must be contained.

## **Metal Items**

Separate into one pile. This includes: appliances, water heaters, chairs, iron post, fencing and aluminum goods.

## **Bulk Household Items**

Large items (mattresses, sofas, tables etc.)

**Items that CAN NOT be placed at side of road:**

**Automotive products, car batteries, pesticides, household batteries, paint, and related products.**

Call 256-882-0155, **Handle With Care Collection Center**, located at 1055 A Cleaner Way to dispose of these items.

**Treated wood** must be taken to the City of Huntsville Landfill

**Construction materials such as: Shingles, insulation, concrete blocks, roads, cement and like materials.**

Individuals may take these items to the City of Huntsville Landfill, call 256-881-8700.

**We do NOT pick up debris generated by professional services such as home reconstruction or tree disposal.**

**Household garbage & waste** – must be put in green trash can.

**Tires**- Our landfill does not accept tires. You can drop them off at our office M-F 7:00am – 3:30pm. **MUST** be removed from rim & free of dirt/debris. We can NOT accept tires from commercial vendors. Please contact our office for details.

**All residents are charged \$3 a month on their utility bill for this service. The amount of debris we pick up at each house per month should fit into a standard pickup truck bed. If your items exceed this, please call our office for SPECIAL SERVICE. The minimum charge is \$50.00. The fee depends on manpower, equipment, and disposal fees.**
